

**Transcript of 911-telephone call: Caller ID shows the call coming from 773-784-2052, Martin Zeller, 131 N. Lombard, Marshall City, MR.**

**Date/Time: 12 Sept 01 @ 1744 CST**

**Operator Franks: 911. State your problem.**

**Voice: Oh! We've been poisoned. We need an ambulance. 131 North Lombard, here in the city.**

**Operator: 131 North Lombard, Stand by. (Pause) What kind of poison?**

**Voice: I think cyanide. Patti is on the floor – spit it out, Patti -- she took an aspirin and got sick. She fell down. I gave her water and told her to spit everything out. Cyanide. I think it's cyanide.**

**Operator: OK. Keep her quiet. A paramedic and an ambulance are on the way with a cyanide kit. Stay calm. What is your name?**

**Voice: Zeller. Marty Zeller. We're married. Patty. Oh my god! Patty!**

**Operator: Stay on the phone. What did Patty drink?**

**Voice: Drink? Water. Just water and the aspirin. Hang on (background: Patty, just lay still. The ambulance is coming. OK, honey?)**

**Operator: OK, stay calm. The ambulance will be right there.**

**Voice: We want to go to the Thompson Medical. It's right down the street.**

**Operator: I'll notify the driver. Stay on the line [long silent pause]. I'm back on. Thompson County Medical Center is good. [Pause].**

**Voice: The ambulance is here. Thank you. Thank you. I'm going.**

**[Hangs up]. Date/Time: 12 Sept 01 @ 1751 CST**
