**TITLE 720
SECTION 8-4: ATTEMPT**

8-4 (a) A person commits attempt when, with the intent to commit a specific offense, he or she does any act which constitutes a substantial step towards the commission of that offense.

**TITLE 720
SECTION 9-1: MURDER**

9-1 (a) A person who kills an individual without lawful justification commits murder if, in performing the acts which cause the death of another:

(1) He or she either intends to kill or do great bodily harm to that individual or another, or knows that such acts will cause death to that individual or another, or

(2) He or she knows that such acts create a strong probability of death or great bodily harm to that individual or another.

**TITLE 720
SECTION 12-4 (c): AGGRAVATED BATTERY**

(c) A person who administers to an individual or causes him/her to take, without his/her consent or by threat or deception, and for other than medical purposes, any intoxicating, poisonous, stupefying, narcotic, anesthetic, or controlled substance commits aggravated battery.
