I hold a Bachelor of Science Degree, with Honors, in Chemistry, and both a Masters and Doctorate Degree in Forensic Science. I have been employed as a forensic chemist for the past 30 years, both at the Metropolitan Laboratory of Forensic Science and the Marshall Department of Law Enforcement and specialize in the examination of drugs and related materials.

Summary of Findings:

Exhibit Crowe - 2/3/03, consists of 115 grams of a hard yellowish substance. I tested 1.1 grams of the substance and found it to be cocaine base, commonly referred to as "crack cocaine," and found it to be 98.3% pure.

Exhibit Davis - 4/13/03, consists of 353 grams of a hard yellowish substance. I tested 3.5 grams of the substance and found it to be cocaine base, commonly referred to as "crack cocaine," and found it to be 98.3% pure.

Based upon visual, chemical, and spectrometric examination, it is my opinion that it is more likely than not that the contents of Exhibit Crowe - 2/3/03, and Exhibit Davis - 4/13/03, came from the same original source.
