Treasure Homes Construction Site on Ranch Way, Marshall City	Complaining Witness: Eddie Harcharwick, Construction Foreman

Nature of Incident:

This report summarizes the events reported in the investigation into an individual apparently stalking or conducting surveillance of the construction site of Treasure Homes. This individual reportedly has been making threats of violence against the workers at the site.

I was first contacted by Stan Harcharwick on December 2, 2005, when Harcharwick called the non-emergency telephone number for the police department to report on-going harassment by an individual. Harcharwick's call was transferred to me. I spoke with Harcharwick who explained the individual makes daily trips to the site, takes photos, holds a sign and yells obscenities for approximately one hour each day, the time of day varying. Harcharwick informs the sign states, "Leaf will save the earth." Of a more threatening nature, the individual often yells that Leaf will make sure the project is never completed. When asked if Harcharwick requested a police presence or further police action at this time, Harcharwick stated that he was told by the project supervisor to make a report. Harcharwick stated they planned to pursue civil legal action against the person after the holidays. They have 24/7 manned security on-site. While Harcharwick did not know the person's name, he said his supervisor was aware of the person's identity. I gave Harcharwick my direct contact information.

I received a phone call from Harcharwick today at approximately 11:00 a.m. wanting a copy of the investigation file. I explained I could only tender an investigation memo at this time. Harcharwick now believes

this individual is named River, is continuing to make threats. Harcharwick stated ELITE Homes intends to file suit against the individual if this behavior continues, probably right after the holidays and told him to get this report from me. When asked if they wanted a police presence or further police action at this time, Harcharwick again stated they have 24/7 manned security on-site and do not require police protection.
