Narrative:

R/O arrived at above address following a call from first floor resident at of 4515 N. Beacon building (a three-unit tenement). R/O found front general entrance door unlocked. R/O went to unit 2. R/O heard a person known as Robbie Johnson yelling, "Stop it! Stop it!" R/O found door open and entered apartment. Johnson stopped shouting. R/O told Johnson to calm down and stay put. R/O walked further into the apartment and saw Pat Hughes standing near the sink, and washing off hands. Hughes admitted to washing off blood. R/O also saw victim lying on the kitchen floor face down, near a small pool of blood. R/O immediately felt aorta pulse, but there was no pulse. R/O immediately called for emergency service to send paramedics and ambulance to scene. R/O then asked what happened and was told that Pat stabbed victim once in the chest with a skewer. R/O asked for the skewer and Pat Hughes said that a knife was thrown out of the kitchen door. At this point other officers from Area Four arrived. After determining that the people present in the apartment were Pat Hughes and Robbie Johnson; Chris Paris, the first floor occupant, was on the back porch. R/O directed officers on scene to place Pat Hughes under arrest, and use cuffs and take Hughes to Area Four station. R/O instructed Johnson to remain in front area, and for Chris Paris to stay out of kitchen so as not to contaminate the scene. Paris went down back porch stairs, and returned via front door stairwell. R/O and other officers searched area inside and outside of building for skewer or knife and any other evidence. No knife or skewer was recovered. R/O did recover a ripped up letter from the front bedroom of the apartment. Robbie Johnson and Chris Paris were later transported to Area Four in a separate vehicle.

Narrative:

R/O arrived on the scene following a personal call from neighbor, Pat Hughes, who made claim that Chris Paris had threatened Hughes with physical violence because Hughes was three months late paying rent. Chris Paris was present when officers arrived and denied making threats. No other witnesses were present. Paris said that Hughes was making this up to avoid paying rent. Hughes claimed that Paris “flashed a gun at me.” Paris denied having a gun. R/O’s on-field determination was that Paris was more credible than Hughes. ASA Navarro, felony review unit, declined to approve felony charge. Warrant Office Studley approved simple assault misdemeanor charges.
