This statement taken regarding the DUI  
of Chris Dunkirk which occurred on October 31, 2008  
at 4544 N. Dover at around 9:30 pm.

I, Terry Smith, am a resident of 4544 N. Dover, Marshall City. On October 31, 2008, I was in front of my home in the evening when I witnessed officer Davis giving a parking ticket to a double-parked car I know to be owned by my neighbor Judge Chris Dunkirk who lives next door to me at 4540 N. Dover..

Judge Dunkirk was obviously intoxicated at the time. Officer Davis calmly and professionally issued a ticket then, and later again to Judge Dunkirk after officer davis conducted several tests.

Officer Davis asked Dunkirk to do a number of things such as walk in a straight line. Dunkirk could not do anything right. . Dunkirk appeared not to be able to talk or walk straight, let alone drive. Judge Dunkirk kept telling the officer, "I am a judge, it is OK."

I came into the police station today to freely give this statement in support of the officer and because I am a concerned citizen; I do believe that people, particularly judges and persons in position of trust, should not operate motor vehicles when they have been taking drugs or alcohol.
