

Downtown Office Of Charity Trashed Coincidence or Conspiracy?

The offices of the Lake Kennedy Federation, an environmental protection organization, was vandalized in the early morning hours yesterday.

Stolen from their offices at 53 W. Johnson were two laptop computers, and a computer station. The laptops contained possibly irreplaceable records of Federation donors and financial activities.

Attorney for the Federation, Connie Cutter, told investigators that this appeared to be part of a plan to undermine the “good work of the Lake Kennedy Federation.”

“It is no coincidence that a remaining Federation laptop that was at the home of one of the Federation’s key employees was also taken in a burglary the same night as the break-in at the Federation.

“Someody out there does not like us,” Cutter added. “The wrote ‘screw the lake’ on the wall in big red letters.”

Cutter also noted that many friends of the Federation had sent in contributions to help defray the cost of repairing the premises.
